

Inter School Quiz Competition Rules for the Oral Quiz - 2017

Team must be nominated by a School. (Registration is free)

- We will have 5 Teams with 2 participants in each Team. Only 5 teams will be registered. (Only one team per school)
- There will be 3 types of Rounds

Round 1: No-Buzzer Round

1 question will be asked to each participant directly

A participant will have **10** seconds to answer the question

Consultation is Not allowed in this round

If a participant comes up with correct answer, his/her team will receive **+2** points

Buzzer will not be used in this round and there is no Negative marking

Round 2: Transfer Round

2 questions will be asked to each team.

Team members may consult with each other

The team will have **10** seconds to answer the question

If the answer is correct, the Team will receive **+2** points

If the team does not answer within **10** seconds or the answer is incorrect, the question will be open to other teams

If another team presses the buzzer and comes up with the correct answer, that team will receive **+1** bonus point

If the team (which pressed the buzzer) does not answer within **10** seconds or the answer is incorrect, it will receive **-1** point (Negative marking) A question can be transferred only once

Round 3: Buzzer Round

10 questions will be asked in this round

Each question will be open to all teams

The team that presses the buzzer will be allowed to answer Team members may consult with each other

The team will have **10** seconds to answer the question

If the answer is correct, the Team will receive **+2** points

If the team does not answer within **10** seconds or the answer is incorrect, it will receive **-2** point (Negative marking)

There will be no Transfers in this round (which means questions will Not be open to other teams)

Disqualification conditions:

There are few conditions where a participant can be disqualified and will no longer participate in the contest.

1. Pressing the Buzzer but not providing a correct answer 3 times in a row
2. At any given point, a participant's net score reaches -3 or lower
